General Guidelines for Life Drawing Sessions. Open Life Drawing meets every other Monday morning in the Classroom at the ECIA Community Center. We start promptly at 10AM, the fee is \$10 for two hours. Space is limited to the first twelve people to arrive. Pencil, charcoal or watercolors are allowed. No solvents or permanent pigments allowed. Everyone gets two chairs one for seating and one to support your paper or board. Small easels are allowed. Our models are professional and will pose unclothed. Please be respectful and refrain from entering and leaving while model is posing. This is not a class - no instruction is given. We have a no conversations while model is posing policy.
